



Class Charts

At Dane Court Grammar School, we use Class Charts as our behaviour management system to record and monitor both positive and negative behaviour events. This platform enables parents and guardians to receive real-time notifications about their child's behaviour, ensuring open communication between home and school. Class Charts also supports our proactive approach to behaviour management, helping us to maintain the high standards of conduct we expect from all pupils.

Recording Positive and Negative Behaviour

Positive behaviours are recognised and celebrated when students demonstrate our core values of being **caring, open-minded, and principled**, as well as through their academic success, active engagement in lessons, and contributions to extra-curricular activities.

Where behaviours do not reflect our school values, they are recorded under two categories:

- **B1** – for low-level behaviours that do not align with our expectations.
- **B2** – for repeated low-level behaviours, or more significant incidents, which require the involvement of a Year Leader or a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

Staying connected with your child's progress

We believe the partnership between home and school is central to supporting each child's progress and wellbeing. Through **Class Charts**, parents and guardians automatically receive email notifications (sent to the address we hold on record) whenever a behaviour event is logged. These notifications provide a brief overview of the event, for example:
